



MediaMaster® is a full-featured media delivery system for schools. It is very easy to use, with support for everything from DVDs to video-on-demand technologies. With MediaMaster, you are assured a flexible and manageable system that seamlessly integrates with your school's MediaMaster network.



- MediaController is an easy-to-use graphical web interface for controlling media resources, digital video servers and DVD players, plus source types such as VHS & LaserDisc.
- MediaScheduler is the title "search & schedule" component of the MediaMaster system. With it, you can find media titles appropriate to an upcoming lesson, schedule them for a future date and receive immediate confirmation that the title will be available.

Students seated in the back of the classroom, where the teacher's voice is lower than in the front of the room, find it more difficult to hear what is being taught, lose interest in learning, and find other ways to occupy their time. The Bogen Orator



system transmits the teacher's voice to all areas of the classroom at the same level so all students can hear and participate in the learning process.

- The teacher or presenter wears a lightweight body-pack/pendant to pickup and then transmit his or her voice
- The teacher speaks at a natural voice level while able to move about the classroom while his or her voice is heard by all students at the same level
- Students sitting in the back of the classroom can hear as well as those sitting at the head of the class
- When background noise is present, the teacher's voice is amplified (not spoken) at a higher level so that outside sounds won't interfere with learning
- Studies have shown that voice reinforcement systems in the classroom help raise achievement test scores
- Teachers report that students are more attentive, remain on task, require less discipline, and are more responsive to vocal instructions as given the first time without need for repetition

On-site or remotely located, a school or school district's media center maintains sole control and physical location of media equipment and media resources. Using an internet browser, teachers request media and digital video to play on their classroom monitors.
